I do it for the purpose of calling the attention of the Senate to what I call the modern history of slavery agitation in this country, going back for the last ten years, and for the purpose of correcting what I think is an erroneous impression, that the Northern people, and especially the Republican party, are responsible for the agitation of the slavery question in Congress. I ask the attention of the Senate and of Senators to the position of affairs now, and to the progress of affairs since 1850, the time when the compromise measures were introduced into Congress. At that time Mr. Webster said, in a speech which he made on the 7th of March, 1850, that the question of slavery was settled in every foot of the territory that then belonged to the United States.
